JPC JETPlan COMPULSORY SUBJECTS:

Each student will undertake SIX JETPlan compulsory subjects in **Year 7** and **Year 8**. English, Mathematics, Science and Health and Physical Education will be year-long courses at both year levels. History and Geography will be scheduled for one semester each year.

JPC JETPlan ELECTIVE SUBJECTS:

Each student will undertake FOUR JETPlan elective subjects in Year 7. Two JETPlan electives will be scheduled during Semester One and the other two will be scheduled during Semester Two.

Each student will undertake FOUR JETPlan elective subjects in Year 8. Two JETPlan electives will be scheduled during Semester One and the other two will be scheduled during Semester Two.

Students are required to rank the elective subjects in their order of priority.
